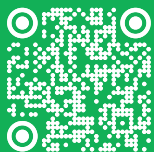

Module set

Session 1 - AI foundations

Translates the standard into defensible operational workflows, focusing on client disclosure, human-in-the-loop verification, and robust audit trails for individual instructions.

Session 4 - Compliance toolkit

Outlines the organisational infrastructure required for safety, including AI use policies, data governance protocols, and the maintenance of a live risk register.
